Before the exam

If you bring your own computer, make sure that you tested that the FLOWlock browser and the camera is working. There are demo-flows in Wiseflow.

You may bring a separate web-cam and an external mouse, but test all equipment with Flowlock.

You may bring two sheets of handwritten notes. It is allowed to write on both sides of the sheets.





At the exam

There are 300 students. Kristian Sandahl and Lena Buffoni will answer questions and visit the Terra building first, starting at 15.00. They will walk along the rows of students, just call their attention when they pass. You don't need to sit with your arm raised all the time. They will split the room so either Kristian or Lena will pass your table.

After that Kristian will go to the Physics building and Lena will go to the A-building. Kristian will catch up in the A-building if there are many questions.

Grading

The multiple-choice questions always have two correct answers. Wrong answers will get minus credits for the rest of the exam. In theory this means that you can have -10 credits in total for the exam if you click two wrong alternatives on all five questions.

Earlier requirements about having minimum credits per knowledge area are removed.

Bonus credits reported in October 2022 will be added to the total amount of credits in a preprocessor of LADOK. This means that you can have a higher grade in LADOK as compared to the results in Wiseflow. LADOK is the official record.
